IN THE NOT-SO-BLEAK MIDWINTER – making your garden interesting in the winter

After becoming director of Oxford Botanic Garden he then moved on to become lecturer in Plant Sciences at Somerville College, Oxford.

While many plants become dormant during this cold, wet and dark time of year, some are providing fruit for the birds and other animals and while others are flowering. Winter may not be the traditional season of big borders and drifts of different blooms but has plenty to offer the gardener.
